Reichstag

Ein langes Wort: Reichstagsgebäude. Das Gebäude steht in Berlin und ist schon sehr alt. Man sieht es oft auf Fotos oder im Fernsehen. Es ist sehr groß und hat **eine Kuppel** aus Glas. Früher kam im Reichstagsgebäude der Reichstag zusammen. So nannte man damals das Parlament. Heute heißt unser Parlament Deutscher Bundestag.

Zwischenzeitlich war **das Gebäude** stark **beschädigt** und **eine Ruine**, dann wurde es für **Ausstellungen** genutzt. Seit 1999 ist es wieder der Sitz des Parlaments.
