- I agree to be a member of the Parent Council and I will try to attend a meeting every half term.
 I understand that some parents will attend meetings as a one off in order to make these as inclusive as possible.
- 2. I understand that the purpose of the group is to be involved in on-going consultation with the school on areas of current practice and future development. As such, I am not a member of a decision making body nor am I a democratically elected parental representative.
- 3. I realise that my role within the Parent Council is to act within a "sounding board" of parents on a range of issues identified by the school. These issues may be to aid the school in reflecting on what it currently does, or provide a range of parental opinions before new ideas or developments are implemented.
- 4. I will not discuss any individual member of staff, governor, parent or student by name or inference.
- 5. I will be free to discuss agenda items with members of the community when gathering opinions to feed back to the Parent Council
- 6. Should any agenda/discussion items be deemed confidential I will not disclose any of these activities to any third party.
- 7. I will not disclose any Parent Council activities to the press or other media any communication with these shall be managed by the Assistant Headteacher on behalf of the Parent Council.
- 8. The agenda will be set by the Assistant Headteacher, and shared in advance. Members of the council can suggest items to the Assistant Head Teacher, who will decide whether to include them.
