## Arrangements for the Year 12 examination session

The Year 12 exams will take place between Monday 28<sup>th</sup> June - Friday 2nd July inclusive.

The exams will take place in a formal exam setting and, as well as giving students and teachers an opportunity to assess progress halfway through A-levels, they are also designed to give students an authentic exam experience, especially as some may have not had such an opportunity since they were in year 10.

During this time Year 12 students are expected to attend all lessons whenever possible in a subject up until they have completed their exam in that subject. If students have an exam in the afternoon, they do not have to be in lessons on that morning.

During the examination window students will not be expected to have to register with their form tutor in the morning or afternoon.

The full June 2021 examination timetable can be viewed on the exams section of our school website [www.uvhs.uk/exams/timetable](http://www.uvhs.uk/exams/timetable) and students have already been e-mailed their own individual exam timetable.

All lessons will resume once the exams are over from Monday 5<sup>th</sup> July and students will begin or continue to be taught new modules or carry on with NEA (coursework). Students are expected to attend all lessons up until the summer holiday.

Results from the internal examinations will be given out to students during lessons before we break up for the summer and we will also issue a subject progress review individually to students and parents.
