Year 12 University of Lancaster visit – Wednesday 8th June

A visit to the University of Lancaster has been arranged for Wednesday 8th June for Year 12 students. This visit is to provide an insight into university life, see the campus facilities and student accommodation and to allow students to consider this as a potential option after sixth form. They will also receive presentations during the day.

Coaches have been booked and will leave outside main school at **9.15 am** arriving back by **3.30 pm**.

We have managed to secure some funding from the university for this trip so we are asking each student to make a voluntary contribution of £2.00.

Year 12 UCAS Higher Education Exhibition – Friday 8th July

A visit to the UCAS Higher Education Exhibition at the University of Cumbria has also been arranged for Year 12 students. This visit is to allow our students to see the range of opportunities that are available after they leave sixth form. The event provides a very good opportunity for students to talk to admission tutors and university students to find out what they really want to know about particular HE institutions, the courses on offer, their location and to pick up the latest prospectuses. Over a hundred universities and FE colleges are usually represented at this event. There will also be general careers information and guidance available.

Coaches have been booked and will leave outside main school at **09.45 am** arriving back again by approximately **2.35 pm**. This means that students are expected to start the school day as normal, attend registration and Period 1 lesson. They should also arrive back in time to attend their Period 6 lesson.

School is unable to cover the cost of this trip so it is necessary to ask each student for a voluntary contribution of £10.00. However, no student will be excluded from the trip and if you have difficulty funding it, please contact me in confidence at school.

We prefer to accept contributions on-line via your ParentPay account for both trips by Friday 27th May. If you have not yet received your ParentPay activation letter, please contact the school Finance Office as soon as possible.

Students who do not attend these trips are expected to come into sixth form as normal.
