







#### Hedgerow wildlife detective



















"We went to a rescue centre there where 6 axolotls, 14 cats, 6 dogs and 4 small creatures like rabbits and hamsters. There were also turkeys. The dog in the photos is Narla; she is a Rhodesian Ridgeback and was used for breeding. She is 3 years old. The Rhodesian Ridgeback is a large-sized dog breed bred in the Southern Africa region. Its forebears can be traced to the semi-domesticated ridged hunting & guarding dogs of the Khoikhoi who were renowned for their heightened ferocity in both of their roles as hunters and guardians. The black dog is Dizzy she is a mixed dog breed. We were seeing if they would be nice to each other because we are thinking of adopting Narla. We also saw a male and female duck, female black bird, and a Robin. They also had goats there, but you can only sponsor them. We were in Lancaster."
















"I learnt a life skill. I did this because it is something I might do as a career. It has definitely inspired me to do more videography, photography and audio and video editing."
