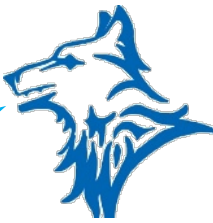

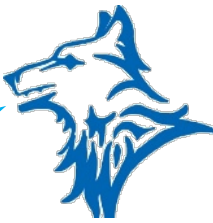

It made me feel a bit disgusted because of the texture of it when we mixed them.

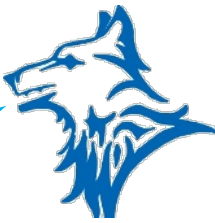
I would recommend it to someone who likes crafts and nature because they would really enjoy the process.

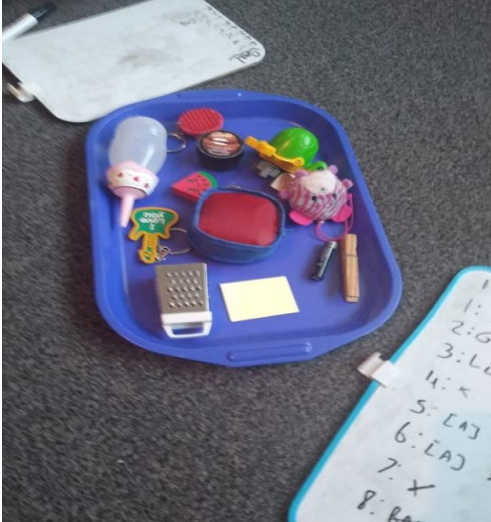

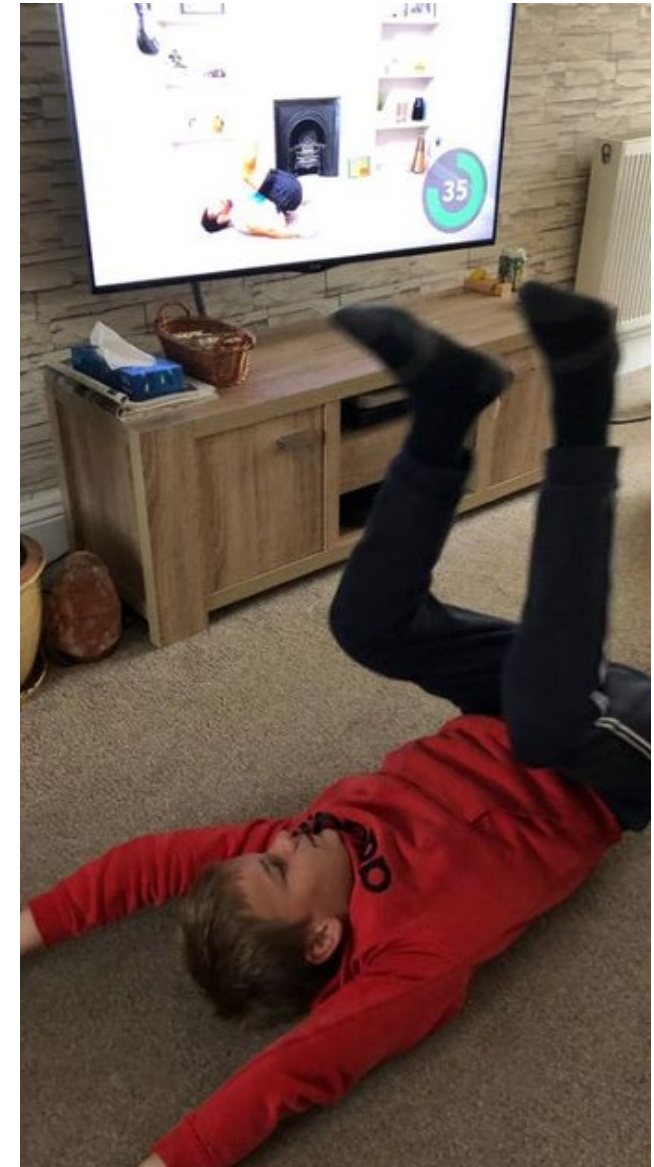
In the first year of Hogwarts she fixed a pair of glasses,

Her best friends are crook-shanks, Harry and Ron.

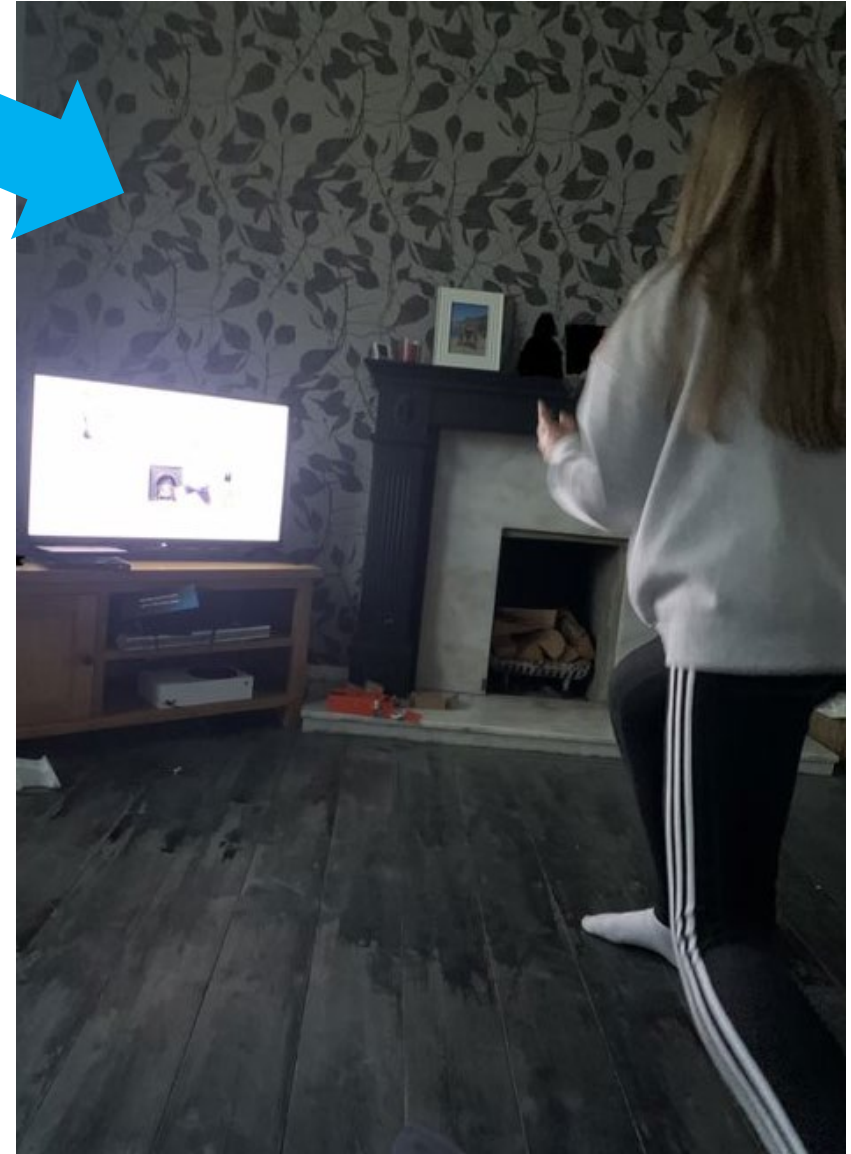

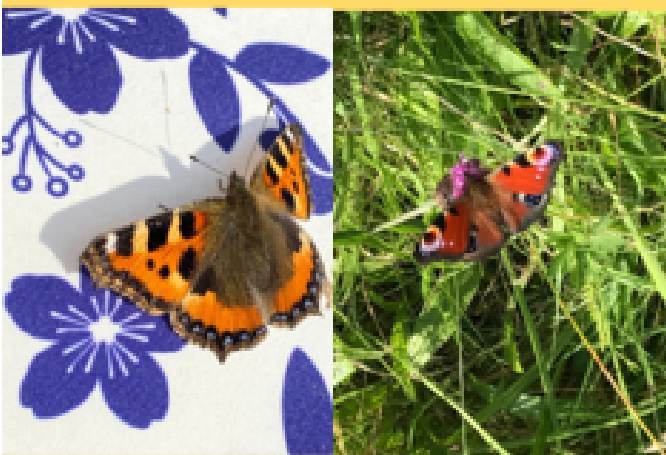

Where a portal was bound

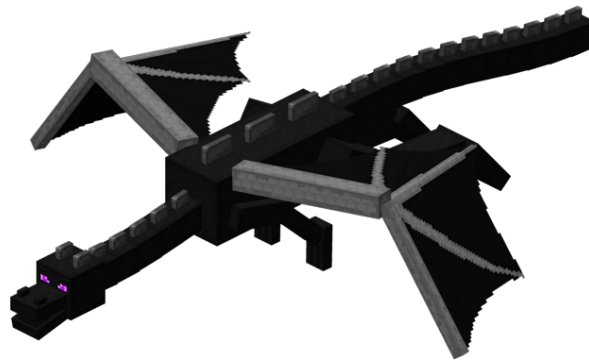
I destroy the crystals that heal;
