Dear Parent/Carer

Year 8 and 9 Languages visit to Germany 8th – 12th July 2024 (Monday – Friday)

The Modern Foreign Languages department is planning an educational visit to Germany in the Summer of 2024. As you will appreciate, this is an exciting opportunity for students to put their German language into practice and experience German culture first-hand and will be fantastic preparation for their further language studies. The visit is being arranged through the company Rondo Travel, who specialise in organising tailor made language tours for school pupils.

We intend to take a group of approximately 50 pupils to the Mosel Valley, where pupils will carry out various language tasks and take part in a wide range of cultural experiences. Time will also be available for sightseeing and recreation, and we feel pupils will enjoy the experience of spending time with their friends whilst they make great progress in German.

The cost of the trip including transport, accommodation, meals and a full programme of activities and entertainment is £550. If you have any difficulty in financing the trip, please write a letter requesting consideration for assistance and the reasons why, to me as soon as possible.

Our proposed itinerary will be:

8 th July	Depart Ulverston by coach to arrive early evening at accommodation
9 th July	Day in Rudesheim – Mechanical museum, cable car and boat trip
10 th July	Reichsburg (castle) and visit to outdoor pool in Cochem
11 th July	Phantasialand Theme Park
12 th July	Depart and return to Ulverston in evening

We prefer to accept contributions on-line via your ParentPay account, A non-refundable deposit of £150 is required by March 31st 2023.

The remaining 4 instalments of £100 each will be payable as follows:

1st July 2023 1st October 2023 1st December 2023 1st February 2024

The number of places is limited to 50 and in the event of the visit being over-subscribed, we will allocate places on a ballot.

Please note it is school policy that any pupil whose behaviour in school would make us question their ability to meet the discipline necessary on a school trip will not be allowed to go. Students with below average attendance may also not be allowed to join the trip.
