UVHS Sixth Form Bursary 2023/2024

Financial support is available to provide help with the cost of meals, transport, books or other courserelated costs or to support specific vulnerable groups. Eligibility includes total household income of $\pounds 23,000$ or below; in care/care leavers; students living independently in receipt of income support; students with disabilities.

If your application is successful, you will be required to submit receipts and/or requests for financial support signed off by the Head of Sixth Form to obtain funding which will be paid directly into your bank account.

Payments will be made only on the basis of full attendance, good timekeeping, satisfactory behaviour and satisfactory completion of work.

- 1. Mainstream bursaries are available to young people aged 16 to 19 in Key stage 5 study.
- 2. In addition, students in the following nominated vulnerable groups: young people in care, care leavers and those in receipt of Income Support or Employment and Support Allowance AND Disability Living Allowance may be eligible for additional support.
- 3. Applications for one off support will be considered at any time.
- 4. All awards are subject to sufficient funding being available to the School from The Department for Education and or Local Authority.
- 5. You must provide all the information requested for your application to be processed.
- 6. Once your application form and evidence have been received, your application will be assessed, and you will be notified of the outcome. Your attendance at school can also affect whether or not you receive financial support.
- 7. If you are going to be absent you must report this to school by telephone on 01229 483900 and you must provide evidence of your appointment on your return i.e. appointment card/letters for Doctor/Dental/Hospital visits. These must be handed in to the Head of Sixth Form.
- 8. Awards may be delayed if more information/evidence is required. Applications without sufficient information or evidence will be rejected.
- 9. To qualify for the Bursary a minimum of 12 hours study per week is required

Appeals against non-qualification for support

If a student's application has not been processed to their satisfaction, they can appeal in writing to the Head Teacher, whose decision is final.

Appeals against non-payment

If applicants are not satisfied with the decision to withhold or defer payment, they should take the following steps:

- 1. Appeals should be in writing to the Head of Sixth Form together with any supporting evidence.
- 2. The Head of Sixth Form will review the information and give a decision.
- 3. If the appeal is rejected, a committee of Pastoral Team members (at least 3 not including the Head of Sixth Form first involved- who will be present to give a report) will consider the case and report their decision in writing within ten working days of receiving the appeal. The applicant may present their case in person.
- 4. If this appeal is rejected, applicants should send a copy of their case to the Head Teacher. The Head Teacher will ask the Pastoral Team for the paperwork and the reasons for their decision.
- 5. Head Teacher's decision is final.
