School Uniform List

All students must wear full school uniform until they reach the Sixth Form when a dress code is applicable. Our aim is to set a standard of dress and appearance which will be appropriate and acceptable for school. We require that parents support us by sending students in the correct uniform and help us to maintain high standards. The initial cost of uniform is offset by the fact that it is worn regularly and eliminates the expense of being the most fashionably dressed. We have tried to ensure that everything required is simple and hardwearing. Where badged items are not required, it is permissible to use other supplies producing clothing of the same style.

Extreme hairstyles/cuts/colours are not acceptable

- Hair bands, clips should be dark coloured.
- Hair colouring should be subtle and sympathetic to the child's natural hair colour.
- Hair styles should not be extreme.
- Hair should not be too short: below a number three all over is not acceptable. However it is permissible to blend hair into the skin on the neck or over the ears, but it must not be shaved.
- Hair shaved on the sides (below a three) and then a distinct change on top is not acceptable.
- Hair styles which result in partially shaved hair, under cuts or lines/patterns in the hair are not acceptable.
- Long hair should be tidy, should not obscure the child's face and must be tied back if it does so.
- Long hair must also be tied back during practical lessons for health and safety reasons. If in doubt please contact school before your child embarks on a new hairstyle. Failure to comply may result in the student being placed in isolation or sent home to rectify hair issues.
- Students are expected to be clean shaven unless it is a matter of religious observance.
- Tattoos are not acceptable.
- Faces should be uncovered.

These rules also apply on non-uniform days.

Sixth Form Dress Code

Sixth Form students at UVHS are role models for younger pupils, whom they will come in to contact with throughout the school day. Therefore, the dress code, while allowing Sixth Formers to express themselves as individuals, emphasises the need for suitable attire; for this reason, very short, tight or revealing clothing is deemed inappropriate. In addition, in interpreting these guidelines Sixth Form students should ensure their overall appearance is in keeping with the working environment of a school which holds high standards of all students. Dress code expectations

- No revealing tops (for example low cut or showing bare midriff).
- Shorts and skirts should be mid-thigh length at the shortest.
- One, small discreet nose stud may be worn.
- No offensive slogans.
- No very torn/ripped jeans.
- No hats in school buildings.
- No outdoor coats to be worn in lessons.
- Sensible footwear (e.g. no flip flops and no open toed shoes in practical lessons).
- No extreme hair colours or hairstyles.

The decision as to whether clothing is deemed appropriate will rest with senior staff in the school and students who are inappropriately dressed may be asked to go home and change.

Lost Property

Students are able to check lost property during the lunchtime. Once every term, items which have been handed in will be displayed and students will be able to collect lost belongings. Items will be held for a maximum of one term and any unclaimed items will be disposed of through local charities.

Mobile Phones

(For the full policy which explains the rationale for these rules please contact school or see the school website)

- The school cannot accept any responsibility for mobile phones on the school site and the safekeeping of mobile devices is at the student's own risk.
- We strongly advise parents to make sure that their children's mobile devices are protected with appropriate filters etc.
- Students are allowed to bring mobiles to school but they must not use them on the school site or on school activities without the express permission of a member of staff.
- Students who use mobiles without permission will have the device confiscated and handed back at the end of the school day. If the device is confiscated three times then it will only be returned to a parent /guardian or a nominated adult with a supporting letter from home.
- Detentions will be issued on confiscations.
- Repeated failures to observe the school rules re mobile phones could result in a ban on bringing mobiles to school and/or exclusion from school.
- The school has the right to examine the contents of a mobile device if there is a suspicion that there has been inappropriate usage.
- The use of a mobile phone to film or record a member of staff or students (or anyone under the auspices of the school) is prohibited under any circumstances and will result in a serious disciplinary action which could include exclusion and/ or a complaint to the police.
- The posting or sending of images (or comments) involving students or staff when they are under the auspices of the school is prohibited and will result in a serious disciplinary action which could include exclusion and/or a complaint to the police.
- Parents should not contact students on mobiles during the school day or during a school activity.
- All contact should be through the school office which is open until 4.30pm. Students who have had their phones confiscated can use the office phone in emergency.
- Phones should be switched off and not on silent.
